

Versatility Entry Program

Purpose: To encourage members to train and work with their Leonbergers in a variety of activities. The Versatility Entry Program recognizes those Leonbergers that have begun working towards a level of accomplishment as versatile working dogs.

7 points from 3 categories are required for the "Versatility Entry" title.

Versatility Entry title requirements

Obedience – 1 point for each activity

- 1. Certified completion of training course
- 2. Canine Good Neighbour/Canine Good Citizen
- 3. Urban Dog Test
- 4. Pre Novice Obedience Title (PCD)

Soundness – 1 point for each test. Testing is for the owner's information and results are not assessed by the programme. Testing should be done before participating in any active sports.

- 1. Temperament Testing
- 2. Genetic Breed Testing: Elbows/hips

LPN1/2 & Lemp Heart Eyes Thyroid

Stock Work - 1 point

Herding Instinct tested – HIC Certificate

Miscellaneous* – 1 point for each activity

- 1. Certified participation in any of the following workshops: Water Rescue, Carting, Tracking
- 2. Modelling, Acting
- 3. Dance

- 4. Public Relations: demos, parades, seminars
- 5. Coursing Ability

*These activities are to be verified in writing by an official (eg., dog club official, school principal, licensed judge, instructor), unrelated to dog owners.

To apply for a Versatility Entry certificate, submit photocopies of titles, certifications and/or verifications to the Club Secretary along with a processing fee of \$5.00. This program is only open to Club members.

Unofficial documented activities not listed will be considered at the discretion of the Club Executive.
